40 years ago...

The summer of 1958 is when it all began. Jane and Sumner Williams started with about twenty campers. The only two cabins were Lakeside and Connestee. The lodge and dining hall back then is what Hank and Townsend's home is today. Imagine, if you could, campers lining up on the back porch to file through the kitchen for dinner, then proceed to the dining hall (currently the living room) to sit down for their meal. The office consisted of one desk in the corner of the living room.

Activities back then included; canoeing, hiking, riding, riflery, swimming, tennis, and crafts. Jane owned about twelve horses at the time. The barn, however, was a single strip like pole barn. It was located next to the large ring by what is now the "old barn." Canoeing took place on the newly constructed lake, which still had some tree stumps peering above the water. The canoes were a classic Old Towne wood stripper/ canvas style. Campfires were held on the hill where today's lodge and dining hall sit. There was only one tennis court and the outdoor rifle range sat where the third tennis court is today.
